Background information:

- Guidance on voluntary withdrawal of a PP between validation and request for registration (EB30, para 41).
- Further guidance on voluntary withdrawal of a PP before and after registration (EB38, para 57).
- Procedures for modalities of communication between PPs and the EB (including communication of voluntary withdrawal) (EB45, Annexes 59 and 60).
- Input by DOE/AE Forum referring to EB30, para 41, where PP ceased to operate under a bankruptcy process and is not available any more to communicate its withdrawal on a voluntary basis.
- Input provided by some EB members highlighting the need for additional guidance, particularly in cases of withdrawal of a PP that is also an FP and in cases due to bankruptcy.
- Feedback obtained in the implementation of the MOC procedures and/or received from external stakeholders relating to perceived limitations/shortcomings.



Critical changes to the current version:

- Editorial:
 - Improved language throughout the text
 - Text is better organised and paras rearranged
 - More consistent use of terms and definitions
- Further operational guidance:
 - PPs have the right to replace FPs at any time and for any reason → para.16
 - Unavailability of authorised signatories (of PPs or FPs) for any reason, including bankruptcy cases → para. 17 (b)
 - Withdrawal of a PP due to bankruptcy which applies also to projects undergoing validation → para. 20 (b)
