Two new members joined JIAG:



- **Future Camp Climate GmbH - leader in the development of JI Projects in Germany;**



- **Green Stream - provides investment and advisory opportunities in the carbon and renewable energy markets.**



Overview of the JIAG's coverage of the JI market:

- **27 %** JIAG market share refer to published PDDs on UNFCCC website (58 JI projects);
- **64%** JIAG market share refer to JI projects with final determination (2 JI projects);
- **100%** JIAG market share refer to JI projects with final verification (1 JI project – Coal Mine Zasyadko).



- JIAG updated internal procedures to communicate with JISC:**
- **Non-member of JIAG can communicate through JIAG;**
 - **Communication to the JISC is free of charge;**
 - **Prior to JISC meeting non-members are invited to send request for submissions to the JISC;**
 - **Conference call between JIAG and non-members on the submissions;**
 - **If there is no consolidated view on the submissions:**
 - JIAG will send to the JISC the project developers' positions; and
 - separately its personal position.

On 30 June 2009 the JIAG has been tentatively accepted by the JISC to act as communication channel for project participants.

Awaiting response from other project participants on the call for public input from any other project participants regarding the establishment of a communication channel and subject to the JISC's final decision, the JISC accepted the JIAG as communication channel.

The JIAG invites JI project participants to provide input by e-mail to the JIAG Secretariat. The input should be clear and well-formulated. All input will be communicated to the JISC. Input that departs from a consolidated view of the JIAG will be communicated to the JISC. In these cases the JISC may indicate that there is no agreement amongst JIAG members on the matter.
