In addition to standard reporting, possible specific issues to highlight:

- continued uncertainty under which working inadequacy of financial resources
- status of accruing of fees to cover costs from 2010
- increased efforts to interact with stakeholders/actors
- concerns raised by stakeholders/actors (incl. uncertainty of future of JI; greater flexibility)
- status of accreditation process & work of IEs
- experience to date with procedures, guidelines, etc. of the JISC - - improving, facilitating, clarifying

JISC 18 (meeting prior to meeting in December)

JISC consider agree on its annual report to the CMP
