Draft language for amending rule 4 of the JISC rules of procedure to clarify that the term of office of alternate members should be limited to a maximum of two consecutive terms would read:

“Alternate members of the Article 6 Supervisory Committee may be eligible to serve a maximum of two consecutive terms. If an alternate member is subsequently elected as a member, his or her term(s) as an alternate member does not count towards his/her term as member.”

This matter was agreed by the JISC previously, but no formal change was made to the rules of procedure. The secretariat’s legal department has advised that it is necessary to formally revise the procedures and inform the CMP. The revisions would be in line with the procedures of other UNFCCC bodies (e.g. Compliance Committee, CDM Executive Board).
